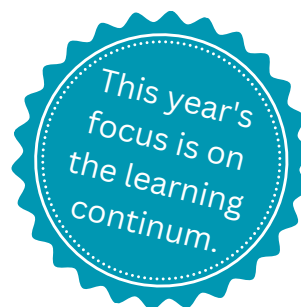
Innovation is an adjustment to move forward, big or small. Be the life-giving momentum for change. Join the academy!

Graduate Credit

You can receive up to two graduate credits at the academy.

The highest goal of the academy is to help districts get to a place where they can run their own internal innovation academy - know so well how to make and sustain change.

What will my Innovation Academy journey look like?



Identify your moonshot (a plan for change), learn how to connect with business and industry with our business leader guests, and conduct stakeholder analysis.



Attend roundtable sessions with past districts and get feedback on your draft moonshot.



Refine your moonshot and expand in the knowledge and practice of the 4 shifts (Higher Level Thinking, Student Agency, Authentic Work, Technology Infusion).



Start a moonshot portfolio and receive feedback on components.



Share and solve challenges with your moonshot with a broader team within the academy.



Give presentations of moonshot to the academy.



The Details

The training is impactful and sustained over a 6-day curriculum focused on four “Big Shifts” that deeper learning schools make:

- 1.Higher Level Thinking
- 2.Student Agency
- 3.Authentic Work
- 4.Technology Infusion

Each district can register teams made of up to 5 participants

- If you only bring teams made up of 1-5 participants, the cost is \$2500.
- Additional team members (over 5) may be added for \$500/per person. You may want this position to be a board member, community member, student or a "flex person" that rotates. In fact, we recommend adding a "flex member"!

The TEAM LEADER must be an administrator at the school district and MUST attend ALL sessions.

If the person filling out the form also wants to attend, put that person's name either in the *Team Leader* or *Team Member* box.

Training to be held at the Bismarck Career Academy in the Multipurpose Room. The Team Leader and Team Members need to attend all of the sessions. Lunch and snacks are provided (we serve great food!).

Leaving the building can be daunting but worth every hour. It's very important and to do this work in person around other schools who have the same growth mindset. Additionally, it's very good for the group to get out of the school to concentrate on the initiative and bond at the academy.
